Organisation des CN: nationale/internationale	Organisation by NCs: national/international
1. On August 5th, 2011, Romania celebrated the Road Worker's Day. The meeting was attended by 150 people, members of the Professional Association of Roads and Bridges, and personalities in the field of roads. On this occasion we've celebrated the 20th anniversary of the appearance of the first edition of the „Roads – Bridges“ magazine and we've made a technical visit on National Road 67 C (Rânca - Obârșia Lotrului). The highway known as the Transalpina, crosses the Parâng mountains in the Carpathians. This is the highest road in Romania, reaching an altitude of 2145 m in the Urdele mountain pass. 2. At Cluj Napoca was organized the National Symposium regarding the Traffic Safety in Actuality – „We participate in Traffic, we are Responsible” – which reached the VIII-th edition. The main objective of the symposium is to acknowledge new modalities of improving the traffic safety through a more efficient management of the traffic, through more performant monitoring and guiding equipment, through the education of the traffic participants according to the users' expectations and the administrators' demands. The presentations have as a subject experience exchanges, the identification of accident hazards, equipment for road safety, the road traffic system management and, last but not least, the aggressiveness of the chemical and sound pollution factors generated by the road traffic, against the human body. The participants are specialists in the road field: construction, design, consultancy, producers and distributors of materials, as well as representatives of companies specialized in road safety. Representatives of universities and foreign companies have also participated.

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The scientific events, who became traditional for the "Academic Days of Timisoara", organized with a periodicity of two years by the Banat Branch together with the Commission on Infrastructure for Transportation of the Romanian Academy - Timisoara Branch and the Faculty of Constructions Timisoara, they known famous participations among the people of science, academics, professionals and manager across the country and abroad. The symposium with the theme "Efficient infrastructures for the land transport", held in Timisoara on 26-27 May 2011, it is the twelfth edition of the scientific events to which they are gathered around 120 experts from all areas of activity in the road sector in the country (education, research, design, construction and administration) and specialists from abroad, and the 54 scientific papers received by the organizers were published in one volume (415 pages) that has been available to participants before the opening of the conference.

Romania has a delegation of 25 people at the World Road Congress. National Reports were sent for three strategic themes: B, C and D. We participate with a poster to the common PIARC pavilion of the National Committees and it ensures the permanence in this pavilion.

The National Congress was held in March 2011 and on August 5th, 2011 took place the National Council meeting. 1. Between 13 and 18 June 2011, the National Company of Highways and National Roads of Romania, as a national coordinator of T.E.M. International Project, held in Suceava the T.E.M. Executive Committee meeting, as well as the annual meeting HEEP (Highway Engineering Exchange Program). The Romanian National Committee supported the participation of 12 students accompanied by teachers, to enter the HEEP professional contest. HEEP is an international organization which promotes the exchange of information relating to highway and bridge engineering, among its members. Specifically addressed is the use of computers in the engineering process. 2. At the conclusion of works on the superstructure of the bridge over the river Mures from the Arad-Timisoara Highway (Arad Ringroad), the Romanian National Committee and the Ministry of Transports and Infrastructure organized a technical meeting in Arad, July 28th, 2011. The bridge is a great engineering work, with a total length of 430 m, with a central span of 150 m, the superstructure beeing made in cantilever of prestressed cast-in-situ concrete.	

Relations internationales	International relations
The International Road Federation held in Bucharest on May 10 to 11, 2011, the symposium entitled "Providing Infrastructure that Improves Road Safety". The Romanian Professional Association of Roads and Bridges, which is a member of the I.R.F., has had a delegation of five people. Topics included: Road safety masterplans and cost effective planning, Vulnerable road users, Road safety audit training, Black spot analysis and measures, the Means to achieve the objectives of the Decade Actions for Road Safety.
